Program participation snapshot:
Academic year 2018-2019 and five year enrollment trends



College Now, a *free* college transition and dual enrollment program, is a major partnership between CUNY and NYCDOE, enlisting 18 colleges and over 420 NYC public high schools in its mission to help students successfully transition to college. The program provides college credit courses aligned with first-year study at CUNY, pre-college courses that increase students' academic readiness for college without a need for remediation, college and career awareness courses and activities, full-day summer programs, and access to CUNY campus facilities and events. In 2018-2019¹, College Now had 33,396 enrollments in courses or activities and served 23,000 students.

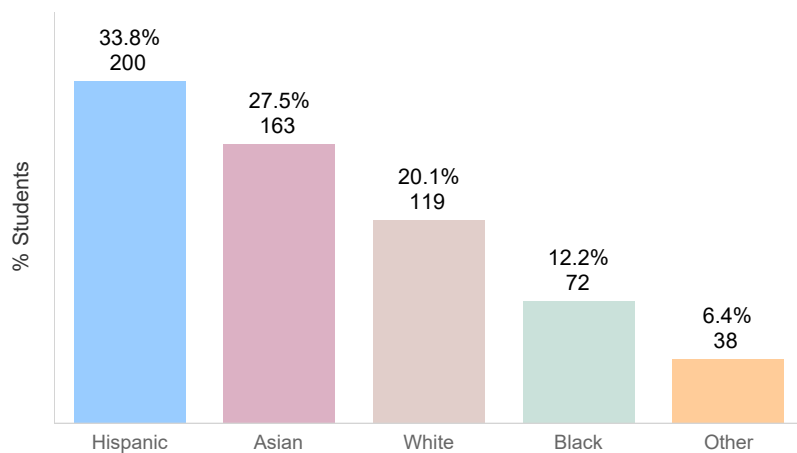
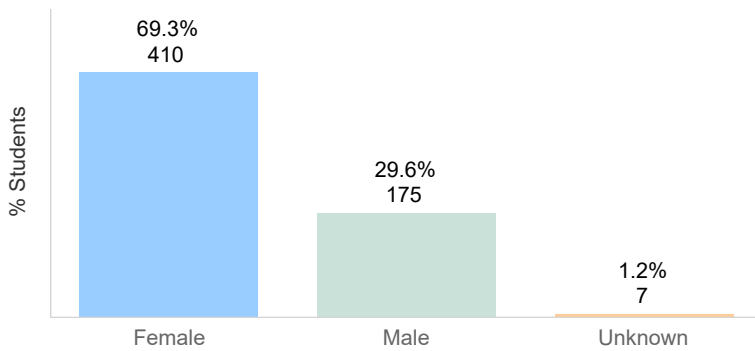

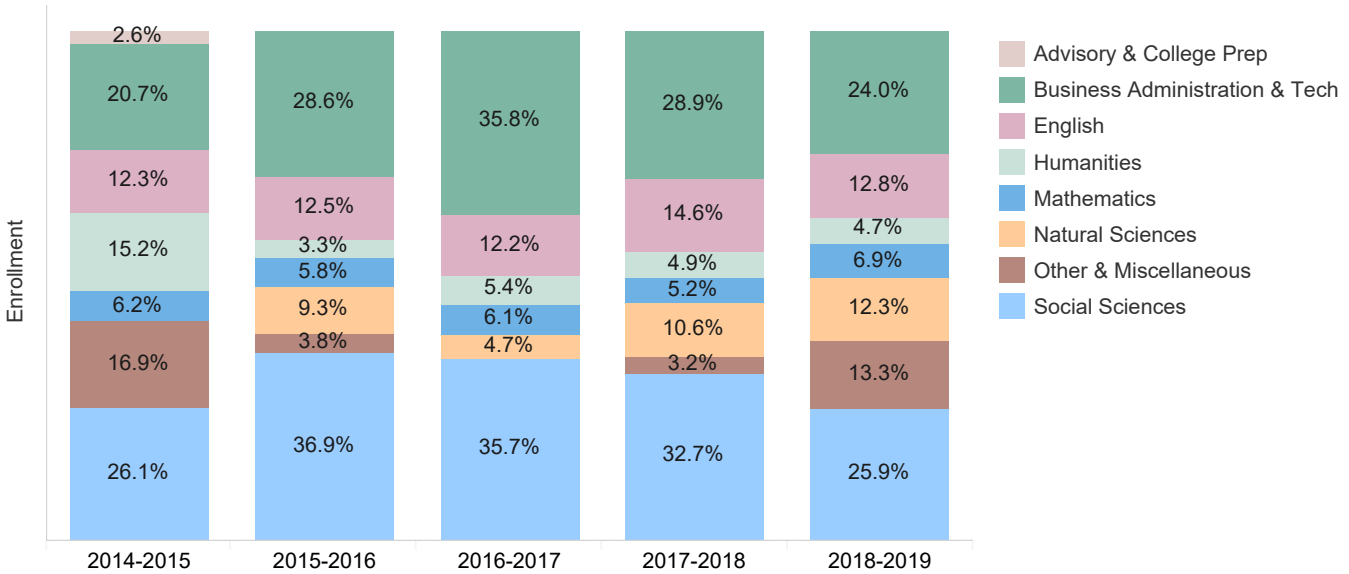

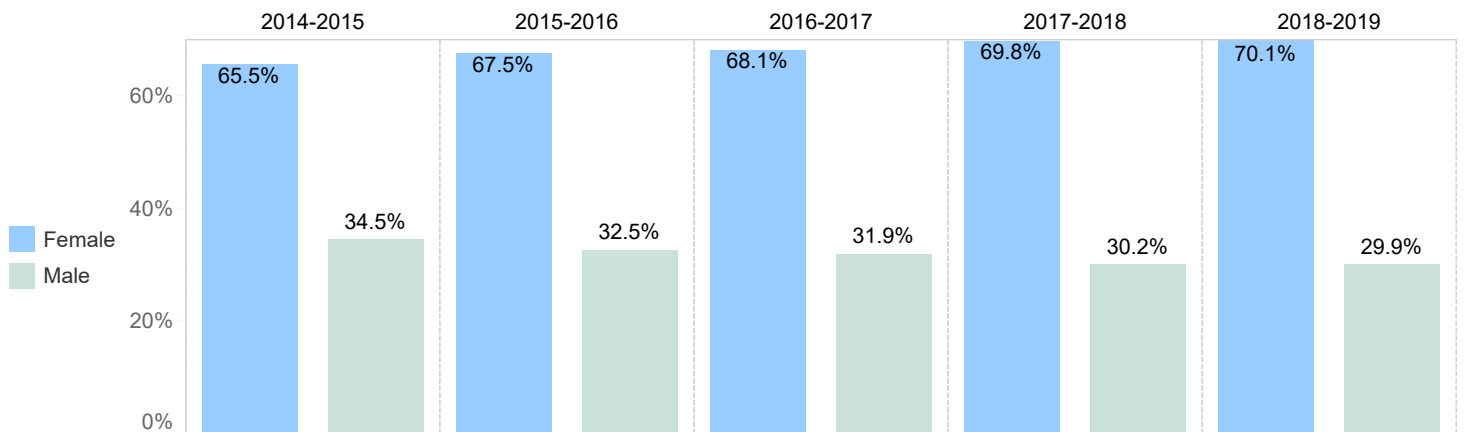

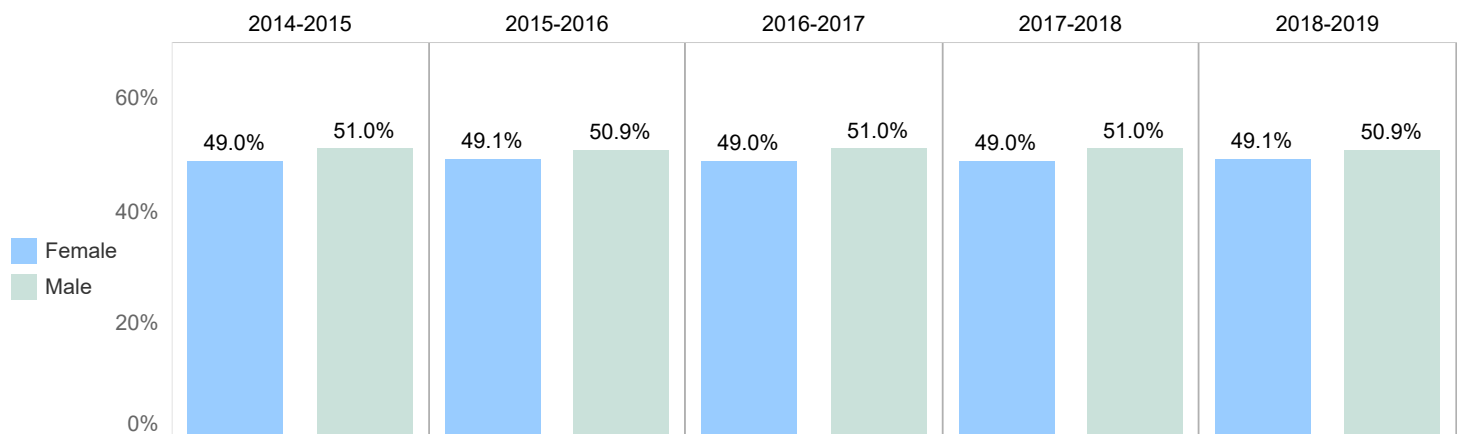

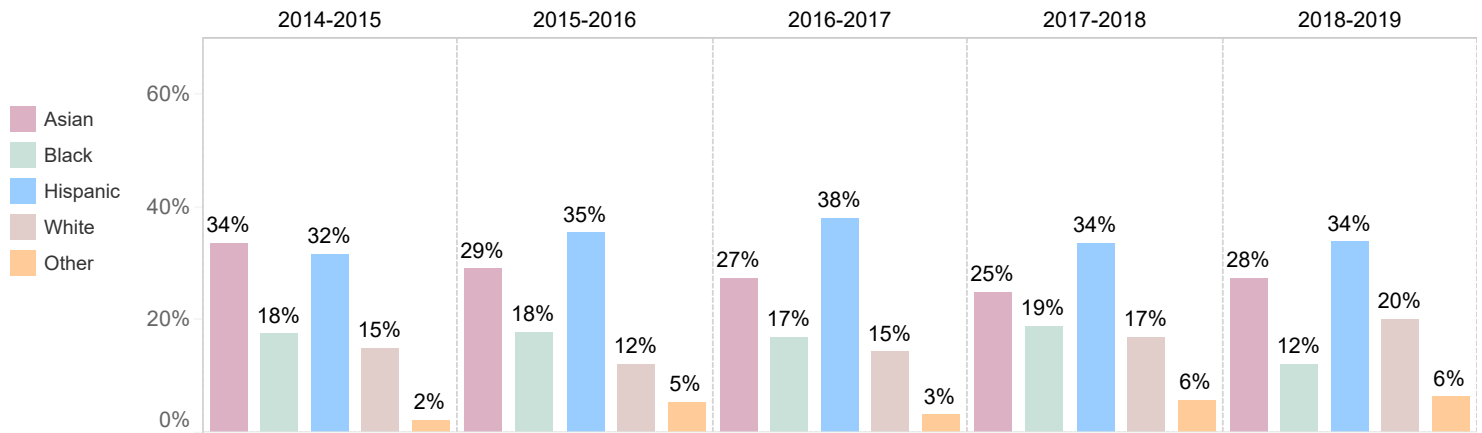

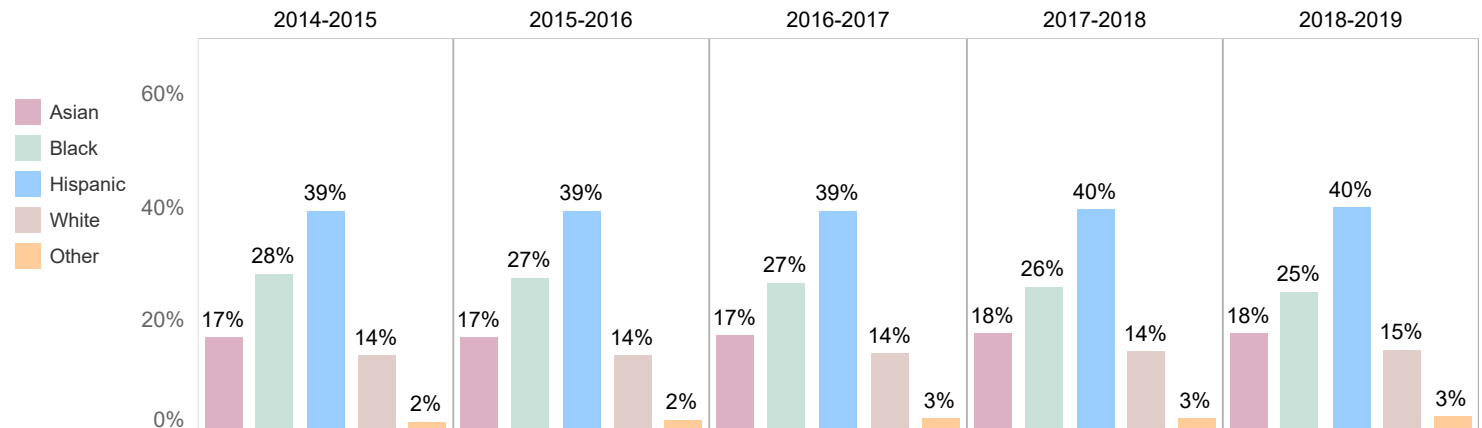

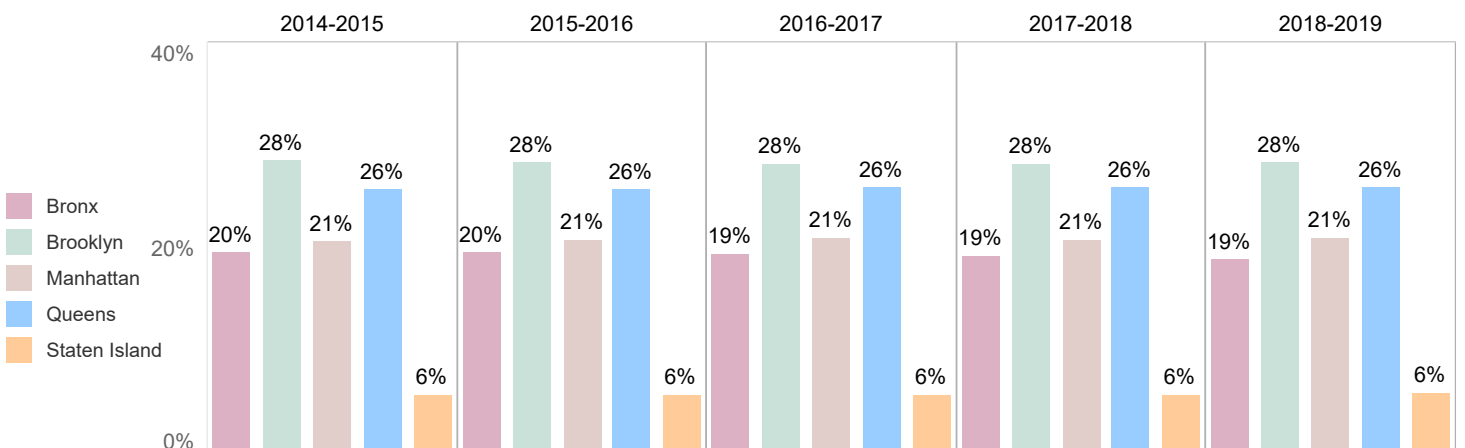

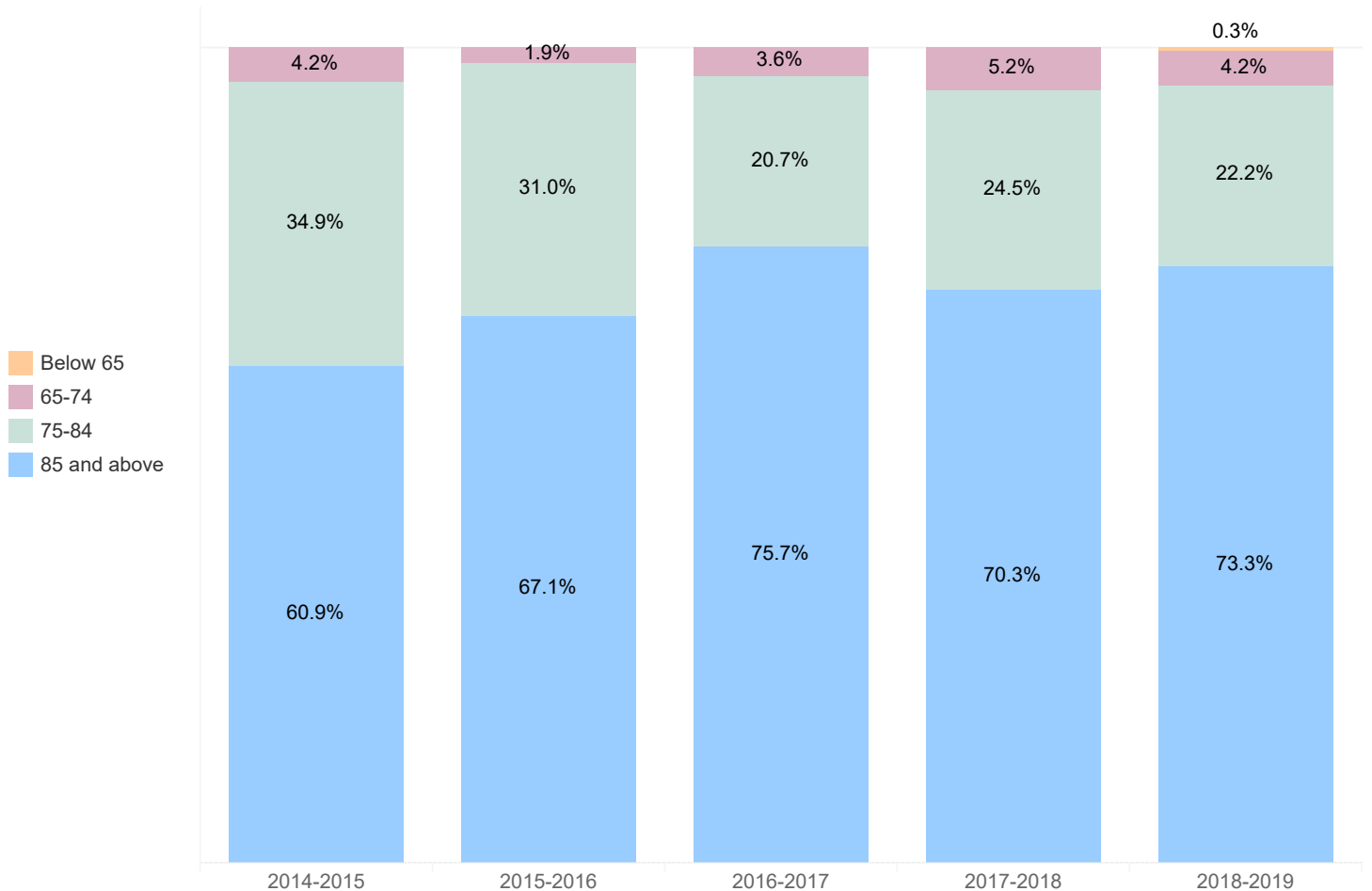

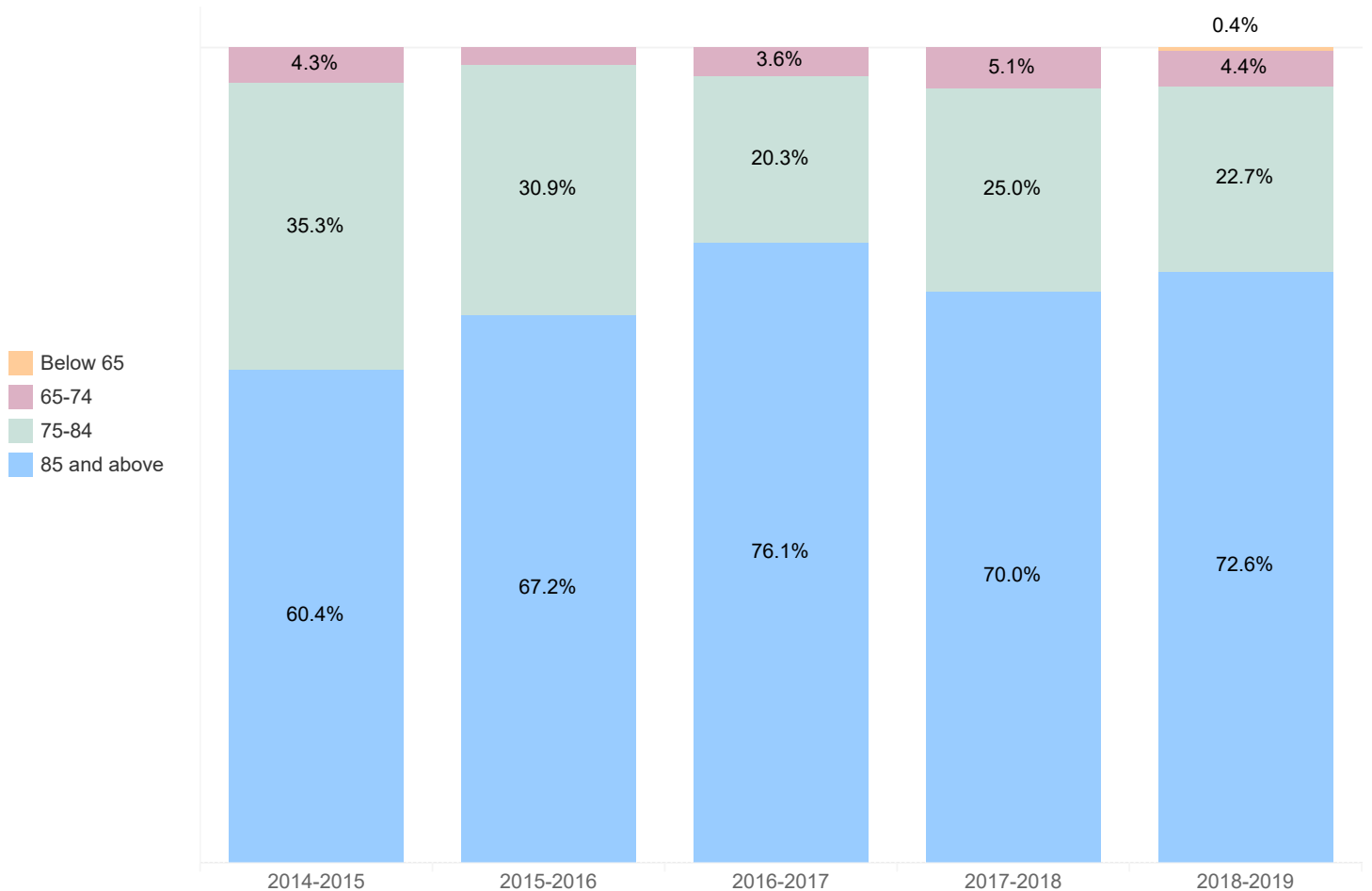

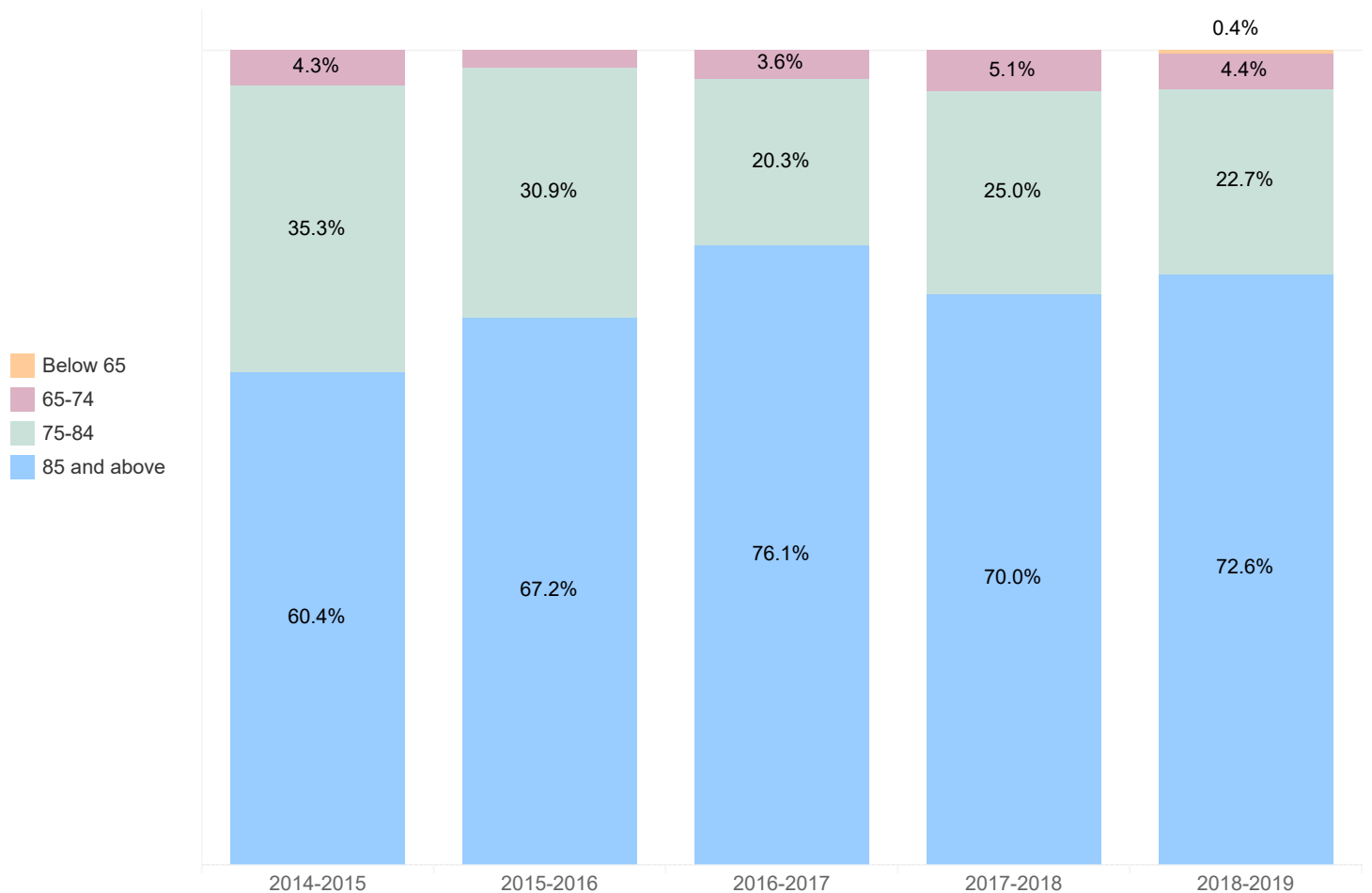
